Sunday January 20<sup>th</sup>                      Research Launch open to TRA Level 2 and above, starting at 10am.

The field has a waiver up to 17,000 feet above the ground for day launches and 3000 feet for the night launch. The field is used for growing corn so we recommend good, sturdy footwear. A Porta-Potty will also be set up for use for those field trips.
